Ward 1 CAN digs into community garden project

As part of the city's effort to engage the community and reduce poverty, part of Delki Dozzi Park in Gatchell is being transformed into a community garden.

The sloping grassed area will be shaped into the starts of the garden this Saturday, May 29. Dozens of Ward One Community Action Network (CAN) volunteers will be moving soil and building raised garden beds from 10:30 a.m. organizers said. Lunch and refreshments will be made available for the workers.

This project will convert 500 square metres of existing lawn to create an interactive community food garden, Rayvin Nyte, volunteer coordinator said, in a press release. The project will be made up of various sized raised beds and is designed to be handicapped accessible.

The community garden will allow Gatchell-area residents to learn about gardening, food, and bring home fresh vegetables, according to Tom Murphy, Ward One CAN chair.

And gardening is a great way to be more physically active and get involved with your community, he added.

The garden will promote organic gardening as well as preparing and preserving food with all ages targeted, Colleen Zilio, garden project leader, noted.

Everyone is welcome to join our garden group, Zilio said. Several beds are dedicated for the community and the food grown will be distributed to families in need and local charities.

Volunteers are needed to help maintain and care for these plants, she explained.

Ward One Coun. Joe Cimino, who is a participant in the planning group, praised volunteers such as Zilio in the initiation of the community initiative and said it fit in with several other community greening projects in the area, such as the beautification of Lorne Street beside Weston Bakeries.
